1. SCOPE

It is the intent of the City of Rochester to establish a contract for Masonry Materials.

2. SPECIFICATIONS

- 2.1 The brick and block listed herein must conform to A.S.T.M. #C90-75 for Grade N Blocks, Type II.
- 2.2 All other items specified in the Proposal must be top quality, standard brand product. If an equal is proposed, it must be identified by manufacturer.
- 2.3 The City reserves the right to require a bidder to provide detailed information about any product they are offering, such as but not limited to the brand name, specifications, etc. The City reserves the right to reject any bid where one or more products offered are not an acceptable quality.

3. CONTRACT TERM

- 3.1 The contract resulting from this bid invitation shall remain in effect for approximately one (1) year beginning on June 1, 2014 and ending on April 30, 2015.
- 3.2 The contract may be extended for three (3) years, in increments of one (1) year or less, upon mutual agreement of the contracting parties.

4. PRICE ADJUSTMENTS

- 4.1 Prices must be firm throughout the term of this contract. Any requests for price increases may only be made at the time of a contract extension.
- 4.2 Requests for price increase will be approved only with proper substantiation from the manufacturer and shall not exceed the manufacturer's published increase.
- 4.3 Price increases will be granted only at the discretion of the Purchasing Agent, and will become effective two weeks after approval.

5. DELIVERY

The items to be furnished under this contract shall be delivered F.O.B., City of Rochester Facility in quantities as requisitioned by that department within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of Purchase Order.

6. SUBMIT WITH BID

Two (2) copies of bid must be submitted with the bid package.

7. QUANTITIES

7.1 The quantities specified are for estimated quantities. However the City may purchase substantially more or less than the quantities shown.

7.2 The City reserves the right to request bids for a separate contract if substantial additional quantities are required, or to negotiate a better price with the contractor, whichever is in the best interest of the City

8. METHOD OF AWARD

8.1 The City expects to award this contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on the TOTAL BID PRICE. Bidders are therefore cautioned to bid on all items, or the bid may be rejected by the Purchasing Agent.

8.2 However, the City reserves the right to award this contract on the basis of items or groups of items if this results in more favorable terms to the City after factoring in the costs of making multiple awards.

9. POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS

Bidders should note that other political subdivisions may participate in the contract resulting from this bid award as authorized by General Municipal Law. Use of this contract by any other political subdivision must be coordinated between that subdivision and the contractor. The City will have no responsibility for any such purchases and will have no other role than to provide other political subdivisions a copy of this contract if requested.

10. ADDITIONAL ITEMS

The City reserves the right to add additional items to the contract similar to those listed on the proposal sheets during the contract term if a price can be mutually agreed between the City and the contractor. All other terms and conditions of the contract will apply to any additional items added.

11. W-9

The bidders W-9 must be included with all bids. Failure to include the W-9 may result in rejection of the bid.

12. NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATION

By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief:

- 12.1 The prices in this bid have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other bidder or with any competitor;
- 12.2 Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not knowingly been disclosed by the bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed prior to the bid opening, directly or indirectly, to any other bidder or to any competitor;
- 12.3 No attempt has been or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.
