1. SCOPE

- 1.1 The City of Rochester requests bids for immediate purchase of two new (2) 2015 Jeep Grand Cherokee Limited, 4X4 sport utility vehicles (Group 1) and two (2) new 2015 Ford Explorer XLT, 4X4 sport utility vehicles (Group 2). Bidders may bid on either Group 1 or Group 2 or both groups.
- 1.2 The City of Rochester reserves the right to order more or less than the quantity stated, due to budgetary considerations.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 The City intends to award a contract for either Group 1 or Group 2, depending on the bids received. However, the City reserves the right to purchase vehicles from both Group 1 and Group 2 if that serves the City's best interest..
- 2.2 Vehicles offered in either group must either be in the dealer's inventory or immediately available to the dealer upon request by the City. If immediate delivery cannot be made because the vehicle has to be ordered from the factory, the Proposal page must indicated the expected delivery date to the City after receipt of order.
- 2.3 The City will determine which vehicle(s) best meet its requirements at the time of award, based upon the models offered in the bid and available options.
- 2.4 Upon acceptance of a bid, the City will issue a purchase order, after which the vehicles will be prepped by the dealer and then delivered the City.
- 2.5 Qualification of Bidders. In addition to all items specified under paragraph 23 of the General Conditions and Instructions to Bidders, the City may consider the following in determining a bidder's responsibility:
 - 2.5.1 That the bidder has been engaged in a high volume sales and servicing business involving vehicles of the type specified herein,
 - 2.5.2 That the bidder employs qualified personnel to render prompt, efficient and quality service, and serves the core of the metropolitan Rochester area.

3. FORMS

All bid forms, including the Proposal pages, Questionnaire sheets, exceptions listing and any other documentation provided must be completed and submitted with the bid. Failure to provide this information may be cause for rejection of the bid.

4. PURCHASE ORDER REQUIRED

- 4.1 Advertisement and receipt of bids for an award of this contract for the equipment specified herein only signifies the City's intention to purchase the equipment specified. This contract shall not obligate the City to purchase any equipment.

- 4.2 The City is only obligated to purchase, and the vendor should only deliver, items ordered on a City of Rochester Purchase Order.

5. CHANGE ORDERS

Minor changes to the equipment specifications may be made subsequent to the order but prior to delivery, upon the mutual written agreement of the vendor and the City. Such changes are intended to permit modifications for upgrades or improvements which the City determines will improve the quality and/or efficiency of the equipment. Additions or deletions which affect the total cost must be authorized by the ordering department and confirmed on a Change Order approved by the Purchasing Agent.

6. CONTRACT PERIOD

- 6.1 The City expects this bid to result in a one-time purchase of vehicles as specified. However, the City reserves the right to order additional vehicles as specified until the manufacturer's build out for 2015 vehicles, at the prices offered in this bid.
- 6.2 If, prior to the build out date the manufacturer increases prices to the dealer, the dealer must notify the City of Rochester. The City may choose to accept the price increase, or not place an order.

7. PRICES

Prices quoted are to be all inclusive, i.e., FOB delivered to the City of Rochester, and inclusive of all costs such as dealer prep charges, etc. including any options ordered.

8. BASIS OF AWARD

- 8.1 This bid will be awarded to a responsive and responsible Bidder based on the lowest Net Delivered Unit Price in a Group.
- 8.2 Bidders may offer Trade-In prices for none, one or both Trade-In Vehicles, as a Trade-In Option included in the bid specification.
- 8.3 Bidders must provide pricing for as many of the options listed in the Proposal as possible. If specific individual options listed are included in a standard retail option package, this should be so noted on the Proposal page.
- 8.4 The City reserves the right to make an award based on in the lowest cost to the City after factoring in any combination of trade-In offers and/or final options and/or delivery dates that meet the best interest of the City.
- 8.5 The City reserves the right to reject any bid that is unrealistic or where a disproportionate unit cost is proposed.

9. GUARANTEES AND WARRANTIES

- 9.1 The Contractor shall furnish the maximum warranty on the base unit as supplied by the manufacturer.
- 9.2 The starting date of warranty for each vehicle shall be the date the vehicle is accepted by the City.
- 9.3 Contractor will be notified by the City of Rochester in writing of the date the vehicle is accepted.
- 9.4 All guarantees and warranties shall be furnished by the Contractor and shall be delivered to the Equipment Services Division upon delivery of the vehicle(s).
- 9.5 The Contractor will be required to supply to the City all dollar amounts for each warranty claim covered by that Contractor.
- 9.6 **SPECIAL NOTE**
- If the Contractor is local, i.e., within the City of Rochester and/or within twenty (20) road miles of the Central Vehicle Maintenance Garage at 945 Mt. Read Blvd., the City will deliver the vehicles to the Contractor's garage for work to be performed under warranty and pick up the vehicle(s) when work is completed.
- 9.7 **IF THE CONTRACTOR IS NOT LOCAL, ALL TRANSPORTATION SHALL BE AT CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.**

11. PAYMENT

11.1 Payment will be made by the City within thirty (30) days after the equipment has been delivered, inspected and accepted by the ordering department.

11.2 If these payment terms are not acceptable to the bidder, the bidder's proposed terms must be shown on the Proposal page. The City reserves the right to reject a bid if the bidder's proposed terms are not acceptable to the City.

12. INFORMATION TO BE FURNISHED WITH BID AND TEST DRIVE

12.1 The bidder shall submit with his bid a complete description, including pictures and catalogs, and all other pertinent data on the vehicle(s) being bid.

12.2 The City reserves the right to request additional information deemed necessary for proper evaluation of bids.

12.3 The City reserves the right to request the opportunity to test drive any vehicle actually offered before the City determines whether or not to make an award. The City will be offered the same test drive options as the bidder offers to standard retail customers (e.g. overnight trial, etc.).

12.4 The City taking a test drive does not obligate the City to accept a vehicle or commit the City to awarding a contract to the bidder. The contract shall only be completed once the City provides a signed contract document and a purchase order for the vehicle(s) to be purchased.

13. MOTOR VEHICLES REGULATIONS

Each vehicle delivered shall be furnished with all equipment necessary to comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles and shall be equipped with Safety Standards required by the Federal Motor Vehicles Safety Standards established by the National Traffic Safety Administration, and the Safety Standards required by O.S.H.A. with reference to the operation of such vehicle(s) within the State of New York. A valid New York State inspection sticker will be supplied with each vehicle.

14. SERVICING

Each vehicle shall be completely serviced under the manufacturer's new car delivery requirements. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to insure at that time all components and accessories have been properly installed.

15. PARTS AVAILABILITY

The bidder understands and agrees to make available to the City of Rochester, Original Equipment Manufacturer's (OEM) parts for this equipment for a period of five years. In the event that during such five-year period the City is unable to establish a contract for the purchase of OEM parts by the standard advertised bidding process, the contractor agrees to supply to the City OEM parts at a price no greater than the then current Fleet list Price, F.O.B. delivered, within the time frames standard to the industry.

16. TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETINS

The contractor shall also furnish any and all bulletins, modification notices, service letters, and related addenda throughout the life of equipment being furnished under this contract. This data shall be sent to the City of Rochester, Motor Equipment Division, 945 Mt. Read Boulevard, Bldg. #100, Rochester, NY 14615, Attn: Fleet Manager.

17. ADVERTISING

Except for inconspicuous identification plates, serial number plates, precautionary instruction plates, etc., no name trademark, decal, or other identification, other than that of the manufacturer, shall be applied to the vehicle. Identification of chassis and equipment dealers and installers shall not be attached to the vehicle. In any instance of violation of these restrictions, the cost to the City for removal of such advertising will be deducted from contractor's outstanding claim voucher.

18. DELIVERY

- 18.1 The equipment and components to be furnished under this contract shall be delivered to the City of Rochester, F.O.B. the ordering agency's facility as described on the Purchase Order(s), which shall be in Rochester, New York.
- 18.2 The delivery date shall be as agree by the City and the successful bidder at the time the City commits to the contract and Purchase Order. Delivery is expected to be immediate (i.e. within a few days) if on the dealer's lot, or as soon as the dealer is able to obtain the vehicle(s) offered in the bid, but no later than the final delivery date provided on the Proposal.
- 18.3 The vehicle(s) shall remain the property of the bidder until accepted by the City of Rochester. Upon delivery, the vehicle(s) shall be thoroughly tested in operation in the presence of an authorized representative of the City to check on the performance of the equipment and operation of the unit as a whole. - 19.2 Rebates/incentives cannot be included in the prices bid if there are any conditions attached, such as must take delivery by a certain date, etc.

20. SPECIFICATIONS

- 20.1 The detailed design specifications prescribed herein are intended to describe units which have been determined to meet performance parameters and characteristics required by the City of Rochester. Bidders having units which fully meet the intent of the specifications, but may vary in a non-substantial manner from the specified design characteristics, may offer such equipment as they can demonstrate meets the intended performance requirements. In such case the bidder shall be required to submit with the bid a detailed listing of design variances and a full explanation as to how the units offered will meet the desired performance characteristics. A decision as to equivalency shall be made by the Purchasing Agent, whose decision shall be final.
