10A. **BONDS**

10.1A **BID BOND**

A bid bond in an amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000 00) shall be furnished with each bid. At its option the City shall have the right to accept cash, a certified check, or a letter of credit in satisfaction of this requirement.

10.2A **PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

10.2.1A In the event the Bid Bond is submitted as cash or certified check, the bid security will convert to the performance security upon contract award and will be held by the City for the life of the contract.

-or-

- A. A Performance Bond in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall be furnished as security for the faithful performance by the contractor of all terms and conditions of the contract documents.
- B. A Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall be furnished as security for the claims of laborers and materials suppliers.
- C. Both bonds shall be made out to the City of Rochester, prepared on an approved form and submitted by the contractor to the Purchasing Agent within ten (10) days of notification that his bid was accepted. The surety thereon must be such surety company or companies as are authorized and licensed to transact business in the State of New York. The surety furnishing the Performance Bond and the Labor and Material Payment Bond must waive notice of any change in the contract price or contract time. Attorneys-in-fact who sign bonds must file with each bond a certified copy of their power of attorney to sign said bonds.

10.3A **Alternative Security**

- A. At its option, the City shall have the right to accept cash, a certified check, or a letter of credit in satisfaction of the foregoing requirements.
- B. Any security accepted in lieu of a Performance Bond shall be retained until the City has accepted and paid for all requirements of the contract.
- C. Any security accepted in lieu of a payment bond shall be retained until the City is no longer liable for mechanic's liens against the work of the contract.
