### **8. BIDDING AND PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- 8.1 Each bidder must satisfy himself/herself fully to the work required. Signature of the Bidder on the proposal shall constitute a certification to the City that such bidder is informed regarding all the conditions that will affect the work to be done. Bidder also acknowledges this information was secured by personal investigation and research and accepts full responsibility for his/her bid prices.
- 8.2 During all phases of installation the successful bidder will field-verify site conditions.
- 8.3 In the event that any unforeseen conditions become apparent after award of the contract, the vendor shall be responsible for any additional expenses.
- 8.4 The successful bidder will submit the manufacturer's factory shipping dates and site arrival date to the Project Architect listed in Section 4 of the bid document within 10 days of contract award.

### **9. GUARANTEE AND WARRANTY**

- 9.1 The bidder shall guarantee that the equipment delivered is standard new equipment per the specifications. All equipment shall be guaranteed for a period of five (5) years against defective parts and workmanship/labor. If defects occur during this time, they shall be replaced or corrected by the contractor without cost to the City, except where it shall be clearly shown that the defect is due to misuse
